For patients and their caregivers who seek to enhance the healing process in a secure, warm, and compassionate environment, Help In Healing Home is the independent not-for-profit, donor-sustained, home-away-from home that supports and strengthens their journey to recovery.

Those undergoing this journey experience life-altering challenges that can leave them feeling isolated and overwhelmed. Help In Healing Home makes the difference with affordable accommodations that meet their needs in a beautiful desert setting located at The Village at Mayo Clinic in Phoenix, Arizona.



Our Mission

To inspire healing, comfort and camaraderie for transplant and cancer patients in a caring, home-like setting.

History

Our mission of service started in 1999 as Arizona Transplant House, a respite for recuperating whole-organ transplant patients. Previously, an Arabian horse ranch belonging to Ed and Ruth Tweed, the property was donated to Mayo Clinic in the 1990's by their daughter, Sally Tweed Groom. At that time, the property had space for seven patients.

Responding to innovations in surgeries, clinical trials, and medical treatments not foreseen when Arizona Transplant House was established, the Board of Directors broadened the mission to provide services to a wider range of patients. Consistent with the new mission, the corporation's name was changed to Help In Healing Home Foundation. With this change, HIHH provides a home-away-from-home for whole-organ, stem cell and bone marrow transplant patients, as well as cancer patients.

Though it is not funded, nor managed by Mayo Clinic, Help In Healing Home proudly operates its guest casita program on Mayo Clinic's hospital campus in Phoenix, Arizona. With a current capacity of 42-private rooms, our small, independent non-profit is honored to have this incredible working partnership with Mayo Clinic.
